Brothers,

We are on the eve of the Sacred Triduum. I've said it before but I will say it again, I am sorry that we cannot be together during this Holy Week, but we are together in spirit.

Father Lumpe has a few things to share with you concerning picking-up your Sacred oils and mask/glove kits, and some hospital ministry updates.

FIRST: Attached you will find Excel spreadsheets associated with the four locations to pick up your holy oils and emergency mask/glove kits for priests. To ensure social distancing and safety for all concerned, please contact by phone the Rector/Pastor below to coordinate the time to arrive at each location:

SECOND: Here are some updates/changes concerning hospital ministry:

Concerning **NON-COVID-19** hospital ministry:

- Right now patients at Ohio Health (Grant, Riverside) and OSU (Wexner, East) cannot receive the sacrament of anointing of the sick nor any "pastoral visits." This is being done to help control the

potential spread of the coronavirus. Priests can enter these hospitals only for “end of life” care (the “last sacraments”) for NON-COVID-19 patients.

- Mount Carmel (East, Grove City, Saint Ann’s) is allowing the sacrament of anointing of the sick, but only by the priests assigned to these hospitals. These priests have regular rounds on an alternating schedule throughout the week (please see the attached listing of priests, Page One of “Additional Information” under Mount Carmel NON-COVID Chaplains).
- Most hospitals are asking everyone to wear a mask once they enter a hospital, in addition to answering health questions and having your temperature taken, so please cooperate with them as they have a job to do, and a tough one at that.

Concerning **COVID-19** “end-of-life” sacramental care:

- Attached is a listing of priests by name who were eligible and completed PPE (personal protective equipment) training to do COVID-19 “end of life” sacramental care (the “last sacraments”).
- For the large hospital systems in Franklin County please refer to the two pages with the heading “Additional Information” where you will find contact information for PPE-trained priests (please respect the privacy of priest cell phone numbers), along with contact information for hospital management who oversee chaplaincy departments, and contact information for hospital chaplains (these are CONFIDENTIAL telephone numbers that are being shared with us as priests as part of our working relationship – as a matter of trust with these hospital systems please do not share these numbers).
- You will see primary and back-up contacts listed for the various hospitals.
- Grant Hospital is covered as noted in the attached.
- For Riverside Hospital please contact the "on call" chaplain available through the special Ohio Health Chaplain Call Tree (see attached) to avoid multiple priests responding to the same call from a family member or friend. Fr. Dean Mathewson can also be contacted to help to coordinate “end of life” sacramental care, especially for COVID-19 patients.
- For OSU Hospitals (Wexner, East) the information is self-explanatory with primary priests listed to coordinate/communicate.

If you receive a call for sacramental care in a nursing facility please (1) ask about the situation that you may be entering into with regard to the person's health, and (2) if PPE is needed are they able to supply it to you.

If you receive a call for sacramental care in a private home (condo, apartment, etc.) again please inquire about the situation that you may be entering into. We're discovering that many families are opting these days to have their loved ones die at home where they can be with family and others versus a hospice care or related facility where no visitors are currently allowed in an effort to control spread of the coronavirus. In some cases it would not be surprising for some COVID-19 patients to be at home so that they can die at home with the support and prayers of family and friends. Since these days are far from carrying out our pastoral ministries with a "business as usual" approach, please ask questions and take appropriate precautions before you enter these kinds of situations.

If you have any questions about how to do perform safe pastoral ministry to the sick and those who may be dying please contact Fr. Mathewson or Fr. Lumpe.

FINALLY: May all of you have a blessed and holy experience during the Sacred Triduum. All of you are in my prayers. I do want to share with you this special prayer for Holy Thursday:

My Most Precious Lord Jesus, this night You gathered with Your Apostles to share with them Your last meal. But this was no ordinary meal. This was the gift of Your most Sacred Body and Blood, soon to be broken and poured out on the Cross for the salvation of the world. Allow me, dear Lord, to spend this night in prayer and meditation with You. After the meal, You invited Your Apostles to join You for one hour, to stay awake and keep vigil as You prepared for Your arrest. The Apostles fell asleep, leaving You in Your bitter agony alone. I accept Your gentle invitation of love, dear Lord, to spend this night in vigil with You. May I enter Your Heart as it faced the coming persecution You were to endure for my sins. May I console Your Sacred Heart and know the love and Mercy that flowed forth. Lord, when I face the crosses of my own life, give me Your divine courage and strength to say "Yes" to the Will of the Father. Your love for me is abundant and is perfect in every way. Help me to know that love, to embrace it and to allow it into my life. I make my vigil with You this night, dear Lord. I love You, help me to love You with all my heart. Jesus, I trust in You.
